

"The Sleeping Beauty" was first performed in St. Petersburg in 1890. The Russian composer, Peter Ilyich Tchaikovsky was commissioned to write the music for a ballet based on a fairytale by Charles Perrault. The original production was choreographed by Marius Petipa and the premiere took place on January 15th, 1890 at the Imperial Mariinsky Theatre in the presence of Tsar Alexander III. Though the ballet was recieved favorably, it was not until 1921 that, in London, the ballet finally gained wide acclaim and took a promient place in the classical ballet repertoire.

Prologue

The Lilac Fairy and her fairies gather to celebrate the birth of Princess Aurora, bearing gifts of beauty, grace, wisdom, temperament, generosity, and voice to honor the baby. The Queen and her attendants welcome friends from the kingdom, the fairies, and their attendants.

In the midst of celebrations, thunder and lightning herald the angry arrival of Carabosse, the wicked fairy who is mistakenly not invited to the celebration. The furious Carabosse curses the baby princess by declairing she will prick her finger on a poisoned spindle and die on her sixteenth birthday. The Lilac Fairy intervenes and breaks the evil curse by assuring the Queen that Aurora will only fall into a long sleep after she is pricked. Carabosse leaves and the Queen, the Fairies, and friends happily pay homage to the baby princess.



Act 1 - The Birthday

The lights come up on a colorful garland waltz, celebrating Aurora's sixteenth birthday. Friends, birthday attendants, and the Queen are all on hand to welcome the young princess's first entrance. As the festivities proceed, a cloaked figure appears and entices Aurora to approach her. A spindle is pulled from underneath her cloak and Aurora eagerly grabs it before anyone can stop her. Spinning, enthralled with the yarn, Aurora suddenly pricks her finger. Dropping the spindle, she slowly realizes she is unwell, and finally falls to the ground, surrounded by her friends. The mysterious cloaked figure reveals herself as Carabosse and believes her curse to kill Aurora has worked. Once again, the Lilac Fairy breaks the spell and banishes Carabosse forever from the kingdom. Princess Aurora is carried away as the Lilac Fairy and the night stars put the kingdom into a deep and long sleep.

Act 2 - The Awakening & The Wedding

With the help of night stars, the Lilac Fairy guides the Prince to the spot where Princess Aurora is sleeping on a bed of roses. After awakening her with a kiss, the Prince leads Aurora to the palace where they will be united in marriage.

At the palace, fairies, friends, and fairy tale characters celebrate the wedding of Aurora and the Prince. Sapphires, Puss N' Boots, Little Red Riding Hood and the Wolf, Cinderella and the Fairy Godmother, and the Bluebird play out their stories before Aurora and the Prince are joined together. Everyone pays homage to the royal couple as the Lilac Fairy bestows the final blessing for eternal love on Aurora and her Prince.
